- The tuition fees listed above do not include Value Added Tax (VAT), which is applicable to non-Saudi students.
- Applicants are required to pay a non-refundable admission fee of SAR **2,000** to secure their final admission.
- Commitment Scholarship (Early Payment): The University grants a **10%** tuition discount on the base tuition fees for all bachelor's degree programs to students who do not qualify for the partial scholarships (Ambition Scholarship or Excellence Scholarship), provided that tuition fees are paid within **30** days from the beginning of each academic semester.
- Summer semester tuition is charged at 50% of the regular semester tuition fee. The Commitment Scholarship applies only to programs whose study plans include a summer semester.
- A **30%** tuition scholarship is offered to all newly admitted students in the Bachelor of Nursing, Bachelor of Medical Laboratory Sciences, and Bachelor of Business Administration programs who have obtained a weighted score below **80%** (based on the General Aptitude Test and Academic Achievement Test). Exception: This offer does not apply to the Preparatory Year Program or the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) program. For the MBBS program, newly admitted students are eligible for a **20%** tuition scholarship, provided they achieve a weighted score of at least **90%** (based on the General Aptitude Test and Academic Achievement Test).



Excellence Scholarship

New Students

A **40%** scholarship is awarded for all Bachelor's programs in **Nursing, Medical Laboratory Sciences, and Business Administration**, provided that applicants achieve a weighted score of **80%** or above based on the General Aptitude Test (Qudurat) and the Academic Achievement Test (Tahsili).

This excludes **the Foundation Year Program and the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery program** in the College of Medicine, for which students are eligible for a **30%** scholarship, provided they achieve a weighted score of **95%** or above based on the General Aptitude Test (Qudurat) and the Academic Achievement Test (Tahsili).

Continuing Students:

To qualify for the Excellence Scholarship, students must achieve a minimum annual GPA of **3.75** out of **5.00** in the College of Medicine program, and a minimum semester GPA of **2.75** out of **5.00** in all other college programs.

To maintain the Excellence Scholarship:

For the College of Medicine, students must achieve a minimum GPA of **4.25** out of **5.00**—calculated annually for the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery program and per semester for the Foundation Year Program. For the other colleges (Nursing, Applied Sciences, and Business Administration), students must achieve a minimum semester GPA of **3.75** out of **5.00**.

Ambition Scholarship

New Students

A **30%** scholarship is awarded for all Bachelor's programs in **Nursing, Medical Laboratory Sciences, and Business Administration**, provided that applicants achieve a weighted score of **80%** or above based on the General Aptitude Test (Qudurat) and the Academic Achievement Test (Tahsili).

This excludes **the Foundation Year Program and the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery program** in the College of Medicine, for which students are eligible for a **20%** scholarship, provided they achieve a weighted score of **90%** or above based on the General Aptitude Test (Qudurat) and the Academic Achievement Test (Tahsili).

Continuing Students:

To qualify for the Excellence Scholarship, students must achieve a minimum annual GPA of **4.25** out of **5.00** in the College of Medicine program, and a minimum semester GPA of **3.75** out of **5.00** in all other college programs.

To maintain the Ambition Scholarship:

For the College of Medicine, students must achieve a minimum GPA of **3.25** out of **5.00**—calculated annually for the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery program and per semester for the Foundation Year Program. For the other colleges (Nursing, Applied Sciences, and Business Administration), students must achieve a minimum semester GPA of **2.75** out of **5.00**.

Continuing students may be upgraded to the Excellence Scholarship upon meeting the GPA requirement for the Excellence Scholarship and fulfilling the other requirements set out in the Scholarship Guide.

International Education, Transfer, and Diploma Holder Scholarship

International Education

(American System, British System, and International Baccalaureate):

A **30%** scholarship is awarded for all Bachelor's programs in **Nursing, Medical Laboratory Sciences, and Business Administration**. This excludes the Foundation Year Program and the Bachelor of Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery program in the College of Medicine, for which students are eligible for a **20%** scholarship, provided they achieve a weighted score of **90%** or above for the College of Medicine and **80%** or above for the other colleges, calculated based on the High School Certificate and one additional standardized test, with each contributing **50%** of the weighted score.

Transfer and Diploma Holder Scholarship:

This scholarship is offered to transfer students from other universities and colleges, and to diploma holders. It provides a **30%** scholarship for all colleges at the University, except the College of Medicine, where a **20%** scholarship is offered. The scholarship applies to the first academic year or the first academic semester.

Eligibility Requirements:

- 1- Transfer Students: A minimum GPA of **3.75** out of **5.00** for the College of Medicine, and a minimum GPA of **2.75** out of **5.00** for all other colleges.
- 2- Diploma Holders: A minimum GPA of **2.75** out of **5.00**, or a grade of Good.

Important Note:

1. After the first academic semester in all colleges, or the first academic year in the College of Medicine, the student will be moved to the partial scholarship category for which they meet the eligibility requirements.
2. The scholarship is applicable to Bachelor's degree programs only.
